The National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 created the Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) Program to promote economic self-sufficiency among participating families. Eligible families are connected with the appropriate support services and resources in their communities needed to move the family toward economic self-sufficiency and to obtain employment.

The Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) homeownership program allows families that are assisted under the HCV program to use their voucher to buy a home and receive monthly assistance in meeting homeownership expenses. The HCV homeownership program is available only to families that have been admitted to the HCV program.



- ❖ FSS is an opportunity to improve your personal financial situation.
- ❖ FSS will put cash into a special savings account (called an escrow account) to reward you if you increase your earned income and successfully complete the program.
- ❖ As your earned income increases, so does the amount that FSS deposits into the escrow account for you each month.
- ❖ HCV Homeownership Program will provide pre-assistance and housing counseling to help you achieve homeownership
